



Clarendon Hills Park District Lions Park Pool Rules Posted

1. Parents or guardians are responsible for supervising their children. Lifeguards are on duty to enforce rules & respond in case of emergency.
2. Admission to the pool shall be refused to all patrons having contagious, infectious conditions. Bandages of any kind are not permitted.
3. Persons under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older during the entire visit.
4. Children who are not yet potty-trained are required by the Department of Public Health to wear both a swim diaper and plastic pants while in the pool facility.
5. No coolers or outside food and beverage allowed.
6. All patrons are strongly encouraged to take a shower before entering the pool.
7. School age children (6-year-old and up) may not go through the opposite sex locker room.
8. No video cameras or camera phones are allowed in the locker room or washroom areas.
9. Proper swimming attire is required, no cutoffs, shorts, or street clothes.
10. Children's buggies, wagons, or playpens are not allowed on deck. Strollers are allowed on deck provided that the stroller is 10 feet away from the water.
11. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved floatation devices must be always within one arm reach of a parent or guardian.
12. No smoking is allowed in the facility or within 15ft of any building.
13. Possession and/or consumption of alcohol beverages is strictly forbidden on park district property. A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the pool facility.
14. Glass, soap, lotion, cigarette/tobacco, or other material which might create hazardous conditions shall not be permitted in the swimming pool or on the pool deck.
15. No running, boisterous or rough play is permitted.
16. Spitting, spouting water, blowing the nose, or otherwise introducing contaminants into the pool is not permitted. The pool water is not suitable for drinking.
17. Diving in less than 5 feet deep is not permitted except when allowed for competitive swimming and training.

18. Only soft squish balls will be allowed in the pool.
19. Those paying admission must have a hand stamp if leaving and reentering the facility. No cash refunds will be issued.
20. All patrons must shower before leaving the sand area.
21. The Lions Park Pool staff reserves the right to dismiss a patron(s) whose behavior endangers his or her own safety or the safety of others without a refund.
22. Additional rules may be added by management as needed.
